## SUMMER ASSESSMENT WEEK: 24th - 28th JUNE 2024 (Year 12)

From Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June, all A-level students will be following a bespoke timetable for their Summer Assessments. When Year 12 students are not in exams, they are on study leave which can be completed in school or at home. When they do have exams, they are expected to be in school 30 minutes before their exam is due to start and will be dismissed at the end of their exams. Please see the examination timetable for your child overleaf.

Art students will be taking their Art exam on the Friday before Assessment week on Friday 21st June and this will run in T215 for the whole day.

Year 12 CTEC students will continue in lessons for this week but will also run on the timings below. Please do note that on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June, lessons will finish at the end of session 2 with an extended break time for all students to receive lunch. This will mean all CTEC students who are on site will be dismissed at the end of session two at 2pm, although A-Level students with exams in Session 3 are still required to attend.
