When: 8:15am – 2.45pm; Thursday 4th July 2024.

Uniform: Students should wear their usual school uniform from their primary school.

What to bring: Pencil case, if students do not have one they simply need a pen for writing

As part of the day students will meet their new Form Tutors, take part in a range of fun activities designed to get to know one another.

The day is designed to be a welcoming and informative introduction to the school and will take place while all other year groups are off-site, providing the perfect opportunity for your child to explore and familiarise themselves with the building. Please see the programme attached.

It is very important that your child attends the Transition Day. If they fail to attend they may begin the year in September less prepared than the other students and miss the opportunity to make new friends as well as getting to know staff.
